Easiest used with Washburne Tables or Current Atlas Lookup Tables downloaded from the internet. The Washburne tables must be purchased new each year. Both the Current Atlas and the Washburne Tables are available at many marine outlets such as LFS Marine. Approximately \$25 for the Atlas and \$8 for the Washburne tables.
